1 Innovation Procurement ecosystem map

Dynamic and interactive map of innovation procurement hubs, multipliers, and public authorities to enhance transparency across the landscape and foster exchange

2 Support packages for public authorities

Portfolio of direct consultancy support services to public administrations, covering the most relevant dimensions in the creation and scale-up of IPHs

Community engagement & management

Space for public buyers to exchange on common challenges, share practices that work, and connect with others to accelerate innovation procurement

Co-publishing space strategy

Strategy and plan for digital space enabling early-stage communication on societal challenges and innovation needs for public procurement purposes
